**ORDER GRANTING STATE FARM'S MOTION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS AND TO FILE RECORDS UNDER SEAL**

THIS CAUSE, having come before the Court for an evidentiary hearing on February 3, 2023, upon State Farm's Motion To Determine Confidentiality Of Court Records And To File Records Under Seal and after hearing live testimony, hearing argument of counsel for the parties and having reviewed the file and being otherwise fully advised, it is hereby

ORDERED as follows:

1. State Farm's Motion is Granted. The Court finds that State Farm's formulas, structure and processes for setting pricing of windshield-only claims is confidential, proprietary and constitute trade secret information under section 688.002, *Florida Statutes*. Specifically, State Farm has shown good cause to protect the following documents and testimony related thereto:

- State Farm Glass Replacement Hourly Labor Rate Calculation
- State Farm's Labor Statistics Memo
- Auto Glass Fitters Application/History for State Farm's Offer and Acceptance Program
- Harmon Autoglass Application/History for State Farm's Offer and Acceptance Program

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2. To the extent any of the above-referenced documents, or any portions thereof, are filed in this case, they shall be filed in a sealed envelope, or other container, which on its face, contains the caption of the case, the identity of the party filing the material, the statement “CONFIDENTIAL – FILED UNDER SEAL,” and the following statement:

3. The Clerk of Court is directed to and shall maintain the above-referenced documents under seal at all times until further order of this Court.

4. Any judge assigned to this case, is hereby authorized to review the above-reference documents or any portion thereof for purposes of ruling on any motion pertaining to the documents.
